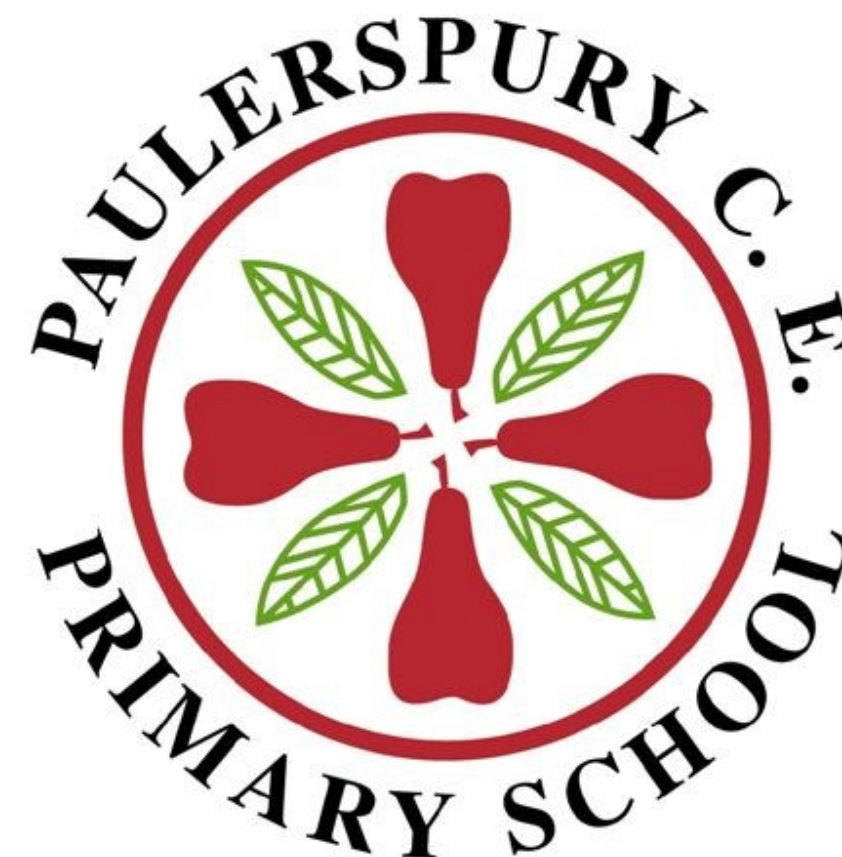

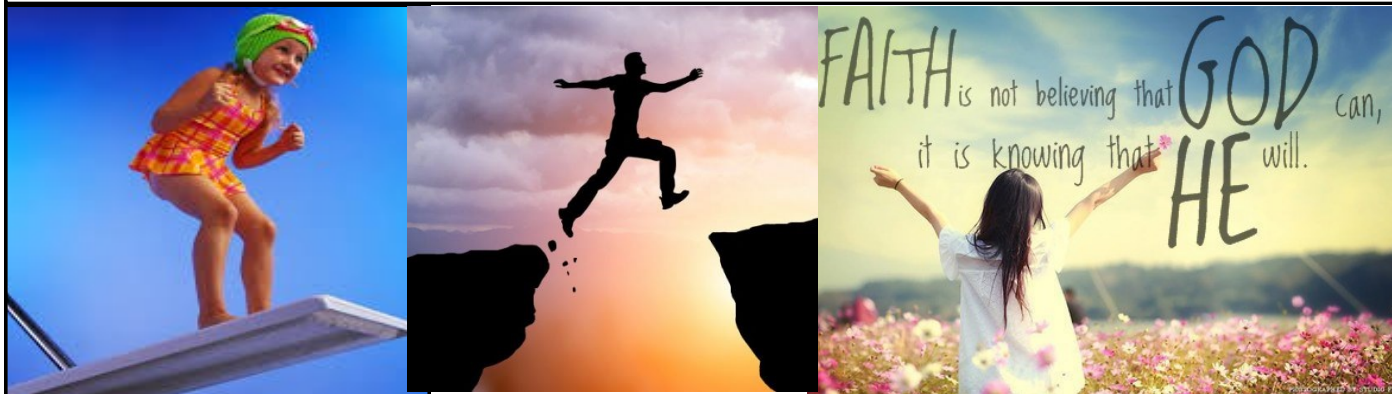
# JULY

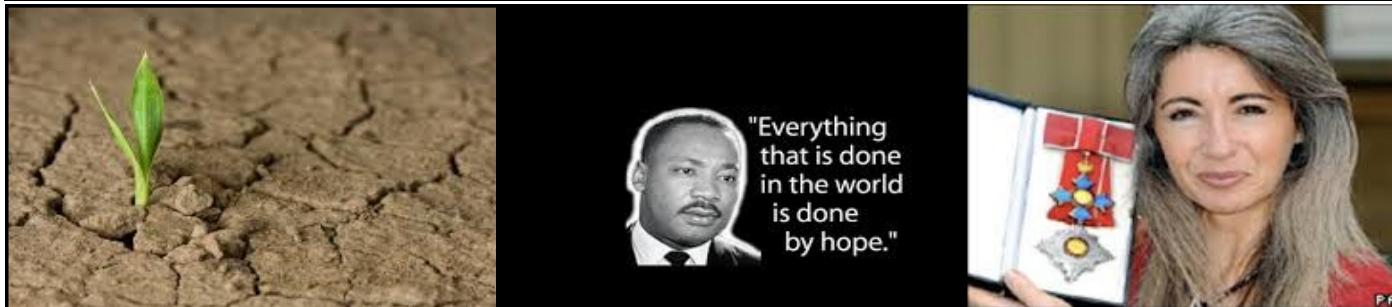
# DECEMBER

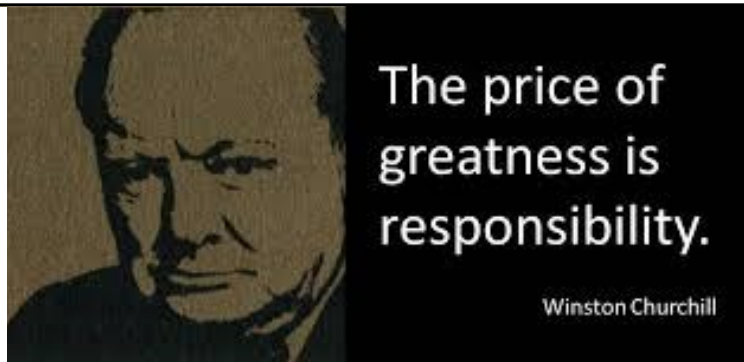
# JANUARY

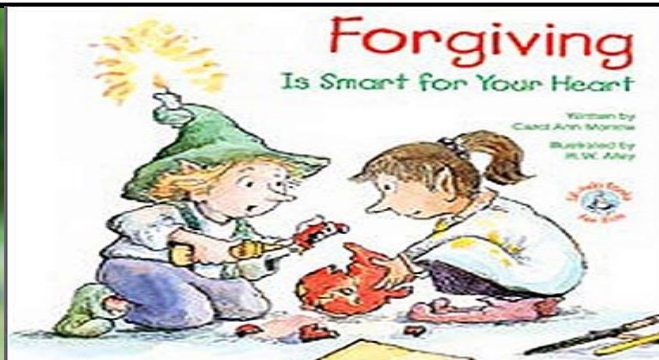
# MARCH
